Plenty of dried fruit with figs and mushroom undertones. Full body, silky tannins and a ripe fruit, lemon rind and spice aftertaste. Condenses down to a refined and beautiful finish. Vivid acidity.

This is the first vintage of famed Italian wine consultant Carlo Ferrini's own Etna wine, and it is a lovely debut. It has a charming nose of red cherries, vanilla, spice and white chocolate. A very Burgundian-style Nerello Mascalese with great purity and precision. Supremely elegant and seductive.

Gavi di Gavi Black Label DOCG, La Scolca 2018

Cortese – Piemonte, Italy

Pale straw in color with delicate greenish highlights. Intense lemon citrus fruit with floral and flinty notes on the nose, comparable to the best wines from Chablis. Medium bodied, with apple and more citrus fruit on the palate as well as notes of almonds and hazelnuts. The finish is crisp, refreshing and long.

Vintage Tunina IGT, Jermann 2016

Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Ribolla Gialla, Malvasisa, Picolit – Friuli, Italy

Jermann Vintage Tunina has a brilliant straw–yellow color with golden highlights. Its aroma is intense, full, with enormous elegance and persistence, and with hints of honey and wild flowers. Its taste is dry, velvety, and very well–orchestrated, with an exceptional persistence due to its particularly full body.

Far Niente Estate 2018

Chardonnay – Napa Valley, California

The 2018 Far Niente Chardonnay offers tropical aromas of citrus and melon layered with honeysuckle, perfume and toasted oak. A juicy entry transitions to a vibrant, yet oily, palate, which builds to a clean and refreshing finish. This wine is well integrated and beautifully concentrated, with lush citrus flavors and hints of minerals.

Powerful, complex aromas of dried plums, with 'balsamic' (anise, fennel, mint) traces. Quite dry (not sweet), soft and with bright acidity, with baked cherry, chocolate and cinnamon flavors and structured, noble tannins.

Madonna Nera, Brunello di Montalcino DOCG 2013 **37/160**

The wine is intense, dense, tight, and deep in flavor with the cherry fruits of the Sangiovese bursting through along with spicy peppery flavours balancing the wine and pulling it altogether.

Cade Estate 2017 **50/250**
Cabernet Sauvignon – Howell Mountains, Napa Valley, California

The 2017 Cade Estate Cabernet Sauvignon has a deep purple-black color and wonderfully pure, vibrant notes of crushed blackcurrants, black cherries and baker's chocolate with touches of Indian spices, licorice and cloves plus an earthy waft of damp soil. Full-bodied, rich and powerful in the mouth with a rock-solid frame of ripe, grainy tannins and seamless freshness, it finishes with layer after layer of black fruit and exotic spices.

BARBARESCO

Barbaresco is characterized by its rich, spicy flavors and perfumed sweetness and is considered more elegant and refined than its counterpart (Barolo), which is a more robust and longer-lived red. Regulations stipulate that Barbaresco must have a minimum alcohol content of 12.5 percent and undergo two years of aging, one of which must be spent in wooden barrels.

BAROLO

Barolo is a traditional hillside village in the rolling hills of Piemonte, northwestern Italy. To earn the name Barolo, the wines must undergo at least 38 months' aging prior to commercial release, of which 18 must be spent in barrel (the remainder in bottle). As the tannins soften over time, the complexity shows through with hints of earth, truffles and dark chocolate.

BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO

Brunello di Montalcino is one Italy's most famous and prestigious wines. All Brunello wine is made exclusively from Sangiovese grapes grown on the slopes around Montalcino – a classic Tuscan hilltop village 20 miles south of Siena. The word Brunello translates roughly as 'little dark one', and is the local vernacular name for Sangiovese Grosso, the large-berried form of Sangiovese which grows in the area.

TENUTA SAN GUIDO

Tenuta San Guido is much better known by the name of its most famous wine – Sassicaia. It is located in the Tuscan region of Maremma and is the only case in Italy of a DOC appellation (Bolgheri Sassicaia) being contained within one estate.
