Light straw with delicate light green reflections. Intense, long, continuous, persistent, from fruity to flowery depending on its step of evolution. Wide, sapid, flint scents, almond and walnut notes at the end.

Excellent as an aperitif or throughout the whole meal; beside the typical white wines pairings (fish, shellfish and seafruits) it doesn't fear the pairing with white meats, poultry and light roasted meats.

Far Niente Estate Chardonnay 2021 **32/150**

The 2019 Far Niente Chardonnay offers tropical aromas of citrus and melon layered with honeysuckle, perfume and toasted oak. A juicy entry transition to a vibrant, yet oily, palate, which builds to a clean and refreshing finish. This wine is well integrated and beautifully concentrated, with lush citrus flavors and hint of minerals.

BARBARESCO

Barbaresco is characterized by its rich, spicy flavors and perfumed sweetness and is considered more elegant and refined than its counterpart (Barolo). Barbaresco must have a minimum alcohol content of 12.5 percent and undergo two years of aging, one of which must be spent in wooden barrels.

BAROLO

Barolo is a traditional hillside village in the rolling hills of Piemonte, northwestern Italy. To earn the name Barolo, the wines must undergo at least 38 months' aging prior to commercial release, of which 18 must be spent in barrel (the remainder in bottle). As the tannins soften over time, the complexity shows through with hints of earth, truffles and dark chocolate.

Located in Val D’Illasi, the estate consists of 65 acres of vines planted to traditional indigenous varieties of Corvina, Corvinone, Rodinella, Oseleta, and Croatina. The estate vineyards and farm are located where the slopes begin to rise toward the mountains and sit 1,000 feet above sea level. The loose, alluvial soils, meticulous pruning and scrupulous viticultural techniques ensure remarkable-quality grapes.
