Excellent as an aperitif or throughout the whole meal; beside the typical white wines pairings (fish, shellfish and seafruits) it doesn't fear the pairing with white meats, poultry and light roasted meats.

**Far Niente Estate Chardonnay 2021**

The 2019 Far Niente Chardonnay offers tropical aromas of citrus and melon layered with honeysuckle, perfume and toasted oak. #### BARBARESCO

Barbaresco is characterized by its rich, spicy flavors and perfumed sweetness and is considered more elegant and refined than its counterpart (Barolo). Barbaresco must have a minimum alcohol content of 12.5 percent and undergo two years of aging, one of which must be spent in wooden barrels.

## BAROLO

Barolo is a traditional hillside village in the rolling hills of Piemonte, northwestern Italy. To earn the name Barolo, the wines must undergo at least 38 months' aging prior to commercial release, of which 18 must be spent in barrel (the remainder in bottle). As the tannins soften over time, the complexity shows through with hints of earth, truffles and dark chocolate.
