**La Grande Dame, Veuve Clicquot 2012** 95  
*Pinot Noir and Chardonnay – Champagne, France*

La Grande Dame 2012 blend is made mainly from grapes from historical Grands Crus vineyards. Pinot Noir dominates the blend at 90%, magnified by 10% Chardonnay. On the nose, intense yet delicate aromas of ripe pears, dried apricots, figs. On the palate, it's a crisp, bubbly, and refreshing wine with flavors of cherry, citrus and spicy finish.

### WHITE

**Gaja, Rossj Bass 2021** 70  
*Chardonnay and Sauvignon – Piemonte, Italy*

An unusual wine for the tradition of Piedmont that Gaja was able to explain perfectly. 95% Chardonnay and 5% Sauvignon Blanc, cultivated on vineyards between Barbaresco and Serralunga. The wine offers floral character, followed by fresh notes of almond and thyme. On the entry, the wine is luscious, with juicy notes of nectarine, pear and pineapple. The bright acidity refreshes the palate, finishing with mineral.

**Chassagne Montrachet, Louis Latour 2021** 95  
*Chardonnay – Bourgogne, France*

Chassagne-Montrachet is located to the south of Puligny-Montrachet in the Côte de Beaune and is one of Burgundy's greatest white wine appellations. The Louis Latour winery was born in 1731. The wine offers aromas of white peach, vanilla and hazelnut. The palate is round with a mineral finish and a note of fresh almond.

### **Amarone della Valpolicella Classico , Tommasi 2018**

*Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella and Oseleta - Veneto, Italy*

Tommasi winery was born in 1902 and today with the 700 hectares of vineyards they are one of the most respectable Amarone wine maker. The wine has a very intense ruby red color, the nose reveals intense and clean scents of very ripe cherry, black cherry, wild berries followed by fresh and slightly spicy tones. In the mouth it is dry and soft at the same time.

The Antinori family has been committed to the art of winemaking for over six centuries since 1385 when Giovanni di Piero Antinori became a member, of the “Arte Fiorentina dei Vinattieri”, the Florentine Winemakers’ Guild. The nose offers notes of small dark fruit, sweet spices, toasted oak, and forest floor. On the palate, tannins are extremely well balanced, refined, and persistent

*Cortese* – Piemonte, Italy

Light straw with delicate light green reflections. Intense, long, continuous, persistent, from fruity to flowery depending on its step of evolution. Wide, sapid, flint scents, almond and walnut notes at the end.

Excellent as an aperitif or throughout the whole meal; beside the typical white wines pairings (fish, shellfish and seafruits) it doesn't fear the pairing with white meats, poultry and light roasted meats.

**Far Niente Estate Chardonnay 2021**

**32/150**

*Chardonnay* – Napa Valley, California

The 2019 Far Niente Chardonnay offers tropical aromas of citrus and melon layered with honeysuckle, perfume and toasted oak. A juicy entry transition to a vibrant, yet oily, palate, which builds to a clean and refreshing finish. This wine is well integrated and beautifully concentrated, with lush citrus flavors and hint of minerals.
