La Grande Dame, Veuve Clicquot 2015 95
Pinot Noir and Chardonnay – Champagne, France

La Grande Dame 2012 blend is made mainly from grapes from historical Grands Crus vineyards. Pinot Noir dominates the blend at 90%, magnified by 10% Chardonnay. On the nose, intense yet delicate aromas of ripe pears, dried apricots, figs. On the palate, it's a crisp, bubbly, and refreshing wine with flavors of cherry, citrus and spicy finish.

WHITE

Chardonnay "Belle Côte", Peter Michael 2020 90
Chardonnay – Knights Valley, Napa Valley, California

In 1982 Sir Peter and Lady Margaret Michael built the Peter Michael Winery on a square mile of rocky volcanic ridges that form the western face of Mount St. Helena in Knights Valley, Sonoma County, California. The 2020 Chardonnay Belle Côte, matured for 12 months in about 40% new French oak, explodes with singular aromas of ginger, lemongrass and Meyer lemon with streaks of flint and dried herbs. The medium-bodied palate is just as intense, offering highly concentrated fruit, seamless acidity, expansive, spicy flavors and a finish that goes on and on.

Chassagne Montrachet, Louis Latour 2021 95
Chardonnay – Bourgogne, France

Chassagne-Montrachet is located to the south of Puligny-Montrachet in the Côte de Beaune and is one of Burgundy's greatest white wine appellations. The Louis Latour winery was born in 1731. The wine offers aromas of white peach, vanilla and hazelnut. The palate is round with a mineral finish and a note of fresh almond.

Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella and Oseleta - Veneto, Italy

Tommasi winery was born in 1902 and today with the 700 hectares of vineyards they are one of the most respectable Amarone wine maker. The wine has a very intense ruby red color, the nose reveals intense and clean scents of very ripe cherry, black cherry, wild berries followed by fresh and slightly spicy tones. In the mouth it is dry and soft at the same time.

Sangiovese, Cab. Sauvignon and Cab. Franc – Bolgheri, Toscana, Italy

The Antinori family has been committed to the art of winemaking for over six centuries since 1385 when Giovanni di Piero Antinori became a member, of the “Arte Fiorentina dei Vinattieri”, the Florentine Winemakers’ Guild. The nose offers notes of small dark fruit, sweet spices, toasted oak, and forest floor. On the palate, tannins are extremely well balanced, refined, and persistent

BARBARESCO

Barbaresco is characterized by its rich, spicy flavors and perfumed sweetness and is considered more elegant and refined than its counterpart (Barolo). Barbaresco must have a minimum alcohol content of 12.5 percent and undergo two years of aging, one of which must be spent in wooden barrels.
