After meticulous experimentation and parcel-by-parcel vinification, the first vintage of Masseto was released in 1986. From its debut, it stood out for its depth, richness, and structure, quickly earning international acclaim.

## TENUTA SAN GUIDO

Tenuta San Guido is the historic Bolgheri estate that revolutionized modern Italian winemaking with the creation of Sassicaia. First produced in the 1940s as a private wine by Marchese Mario Incisa della Rocchetta, Sassicaia was originally made solely for family consumption, inspired by the great wines of Bordeaux. The name "Sassicaia" refers to the estate's stony soils, reminiscent of those found in Graves. In 1978, a landmark tasting in London brought Sassicaia international acclaim, paving the way for the rise of the "Super Tuscans." Today, it stands as a symbol of elegance, longevity, and strong territorial identity in Italian wine.
